

The Current Condition of the Japanese Machine Tool Industry

Monthly Machine Tool Orders (May 2010)

The total value of machine tool orders in May was roughly the same as that of the previous month, falling 0.2% compared to April to 80.6 billion yen. At the same time, May orders rose approximately 2.9 times compared to the same month of the previous year, thus marking the sixth month-on-month increase. These developments indicate that the recovery trend is continuing. Domestic orders rose compared to the previous month; however, this rise still lacks strength due to spot factors among other reasons. On the other hand, although foreign orders showed a decline compared to April, they continued to demonstrate a recovery trend that is led by Asia.

Domestic orders rose by 29.1% compared to the previous month to 28.7 billion yen, thus making May the second consecutive month of increase. May also posted a 132.6% increase compared to the same month of the previous year, making it the sixth consecutive month of increase. Motor vehicles showed a rise of 93.5% due to spot factors, and increases were also seen in industrial machinery, electrical & precision machinery, and other sectors. Such developments suggest a gradual trend toward recovery. However, in terms of actual monetary value, domestic orders have yet to reach a favorable level.

Foreign orders fell by 11.4% from April to 52.0 billion yen, thus making May the first month of decline in four months. However, orders rose by approximately 3.4 times compared to the same month of the previous year, which made May the seventh consecutive month of increase. By region, total orders from Asia accounted for more than 60% of all foreign orders. This was due to continuing strong orders in motor vehicles and electrical machinery from South Korea and China as well as in electronic equipment-related industries and motor vehicles from other parts of Asia. As for orders from Europe, some of Euro member states suffer a serious debt crises and it seems to affect capital investment in the latter half of the year, and thus future developments must be monitored. Orders from North America exceeded 10 billion yen for the third consecutive month, indicating that recovery is continuing.
