

Trends in Exports of Machine Tools

Machine Tool Exports



- According to the Ministry of Finance's Trade Statistics, exports of machine tools in 2024 declined by 8.3% from
 the previous year to 761.7 billion yen, marking the second consecutive year of decline and falling below 800
 billion yen for the first time in three years. Of this, NC machine tools were down 8.4% year-on-year to 733.5 billion
 yen, and their share of the total export value was 96.3%, down 0.2% year-on-year, accounting for most exports.
- Looking at export values by major region, North America declined by 12.7% from the previous year to 205.2 billion yen, and Europe declined by 22.0% from the previous year to 140.5 billion yen, both figures were down for the first time in four years. On the other hand, Asia (392.2 billion yen) saw a slight decrease of 0.4% compared to the previous year, marking a decrease for the second consecutive year.
- By country, China (205.3 billion yen) overtook the United States (178.4 billion yen) to take the top spot for the first time in two years, followed by India (46.6 billion yen), South Korea (30.7 billion yen), and Thailand (28.6 billion yen). Germany (26.1 billion yen), which was at the top last year, saw a 30.4% decrease compared to the previous year, and Chinese Taipei (25.4 billion yen) saw a large decrease of 25.0% compared to the previous year.
- By type of machine, the top three were machining centers (319.1 billion yen, down 9.1% from the previous year),
 NC lathes (200.6 billion yen, down 10.4% from the previous year), and special processing machines (130.1 billion yen, down 11.7% from the previous year), with these top three machines accounting for 85.3% of the total export value.
- The apparent export ratio (export value/production value x 100 (%)) is 84.5%, which exceeded the ratio of orders to foreign demand (70.3%). This is thought to be because the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry's Production Statistics Survey (production) covers business establishments with 50 or more employees, and the Ministry of Finance's trade statistics (exports) include not only new machine tools but also used machine tools.
